Guided by its eight strategic priorities, the EIB Group supports projects that address global challenges, foster innovation, and build a sustainable, resilient future.

The academic programme includes online sessions, plenary lectures and technical seminars with four tracks focussing on either the financial, policy, technical or developmental aspects of EIBG activities.
